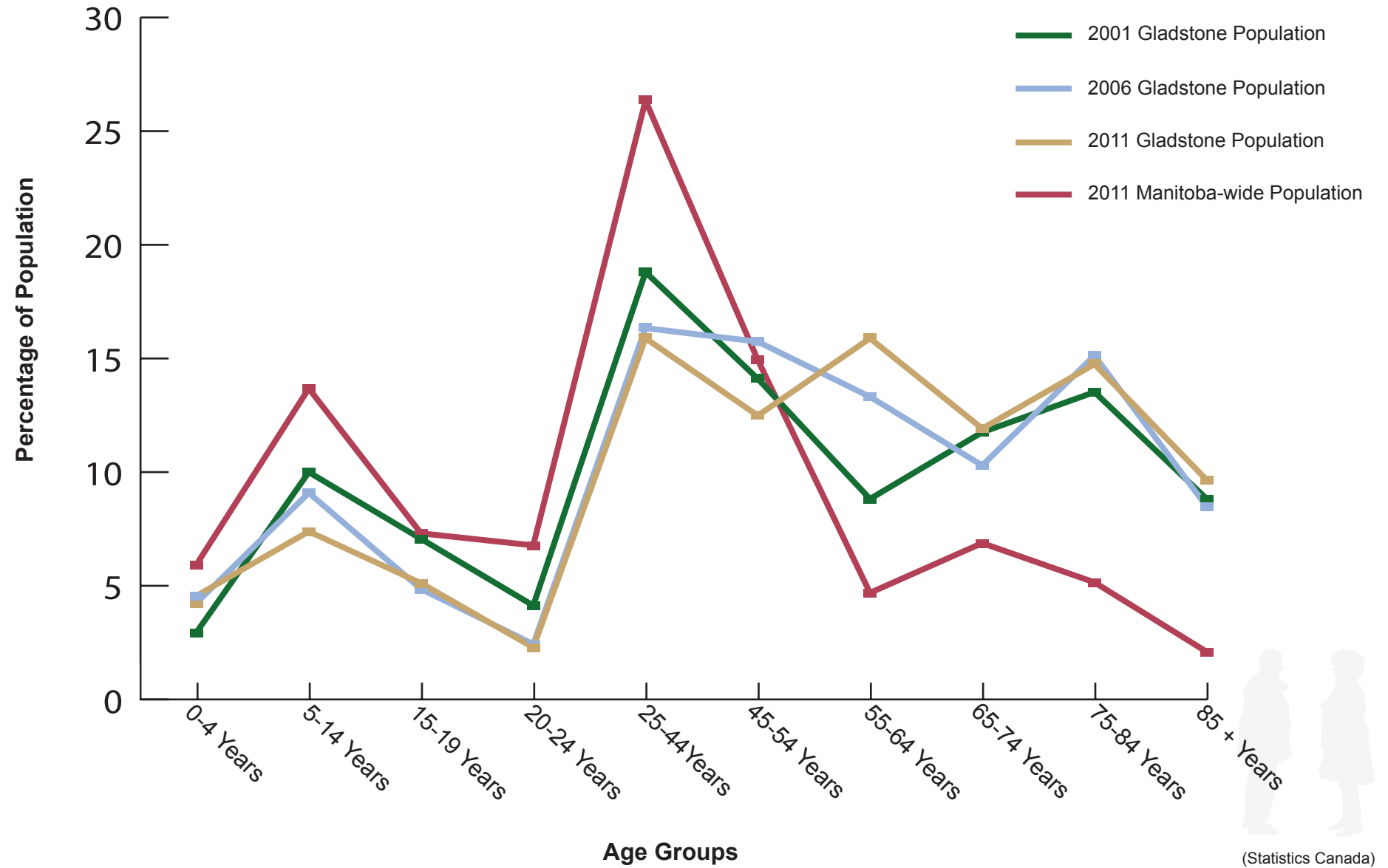

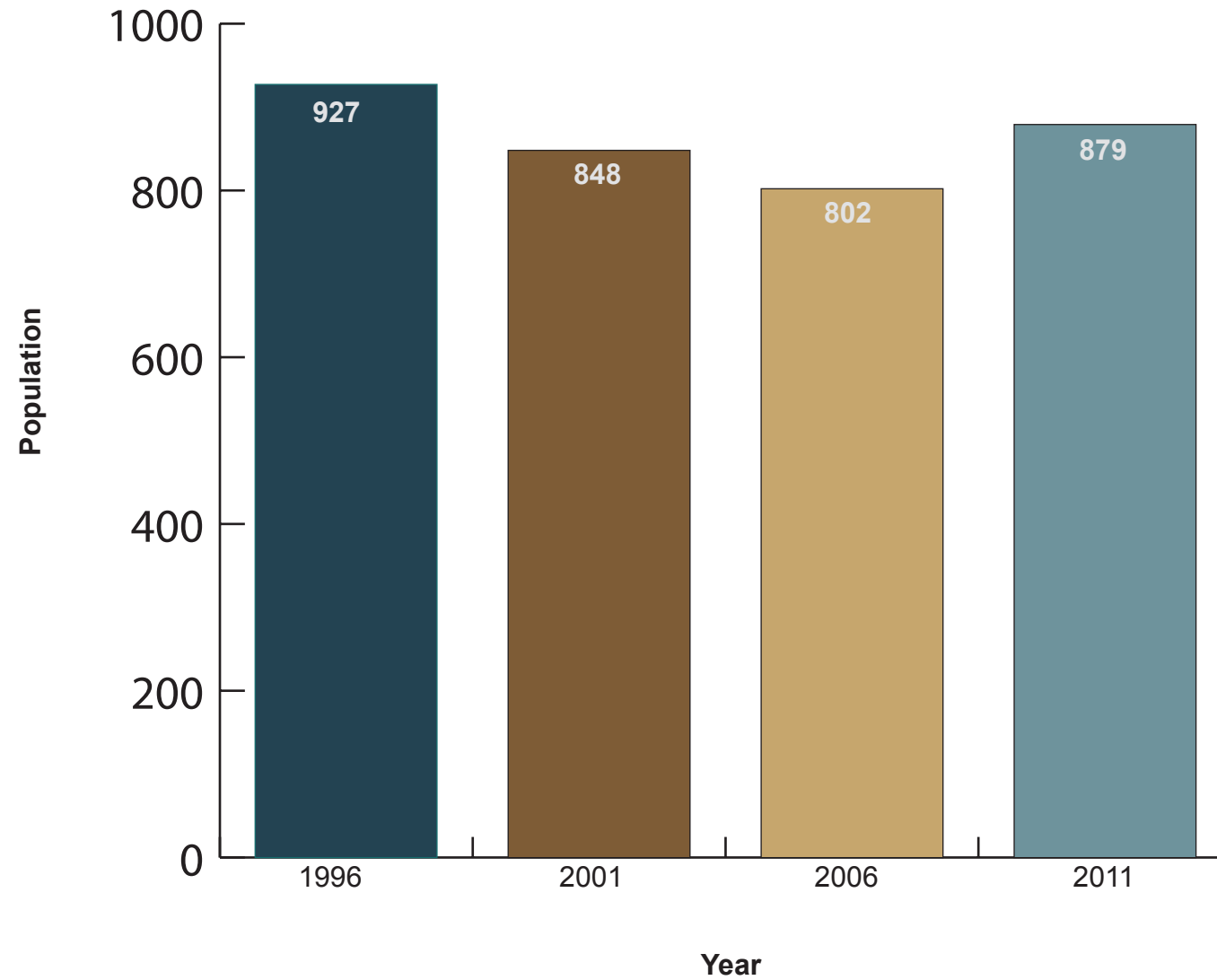


Gladstone's Population by Age



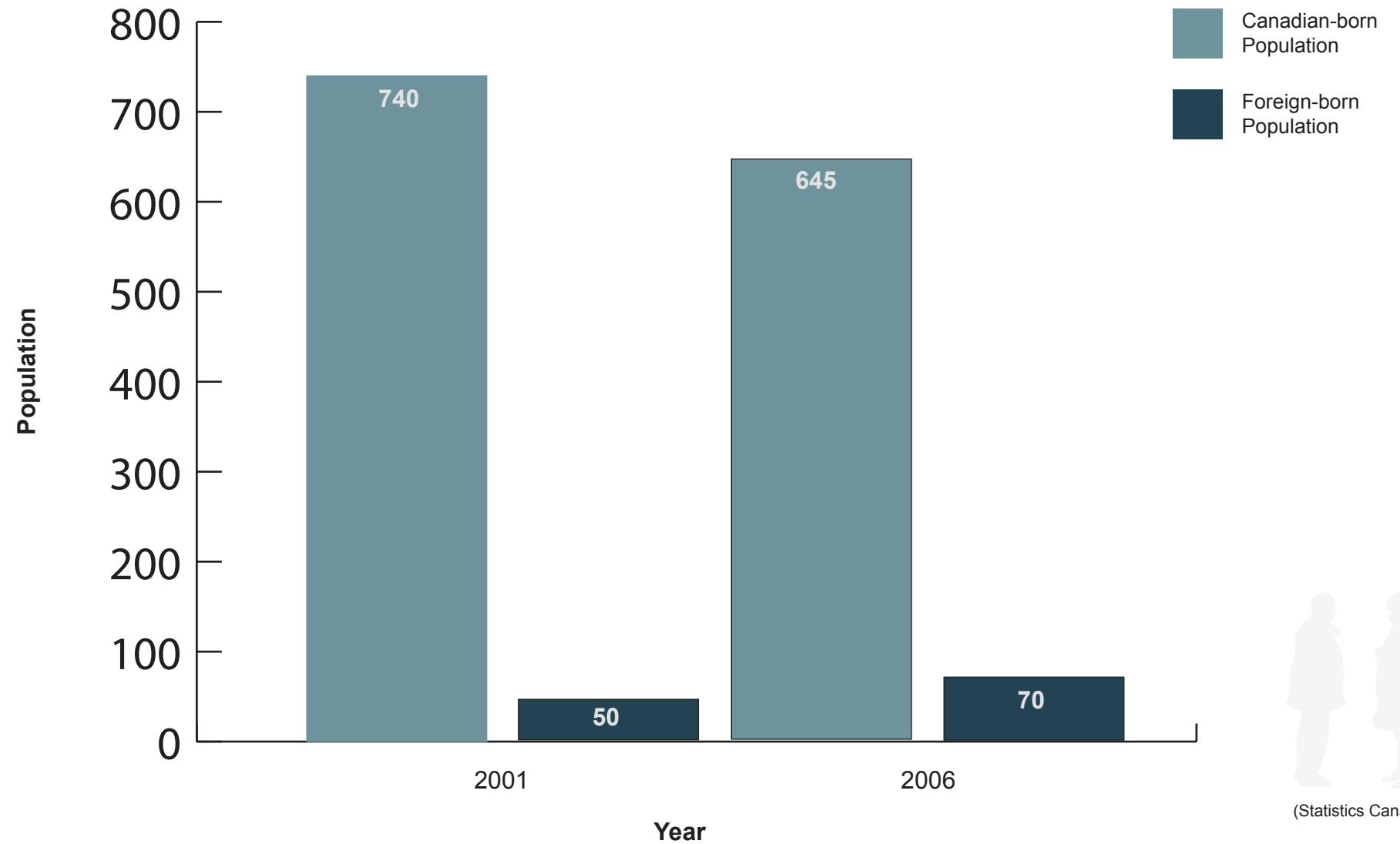

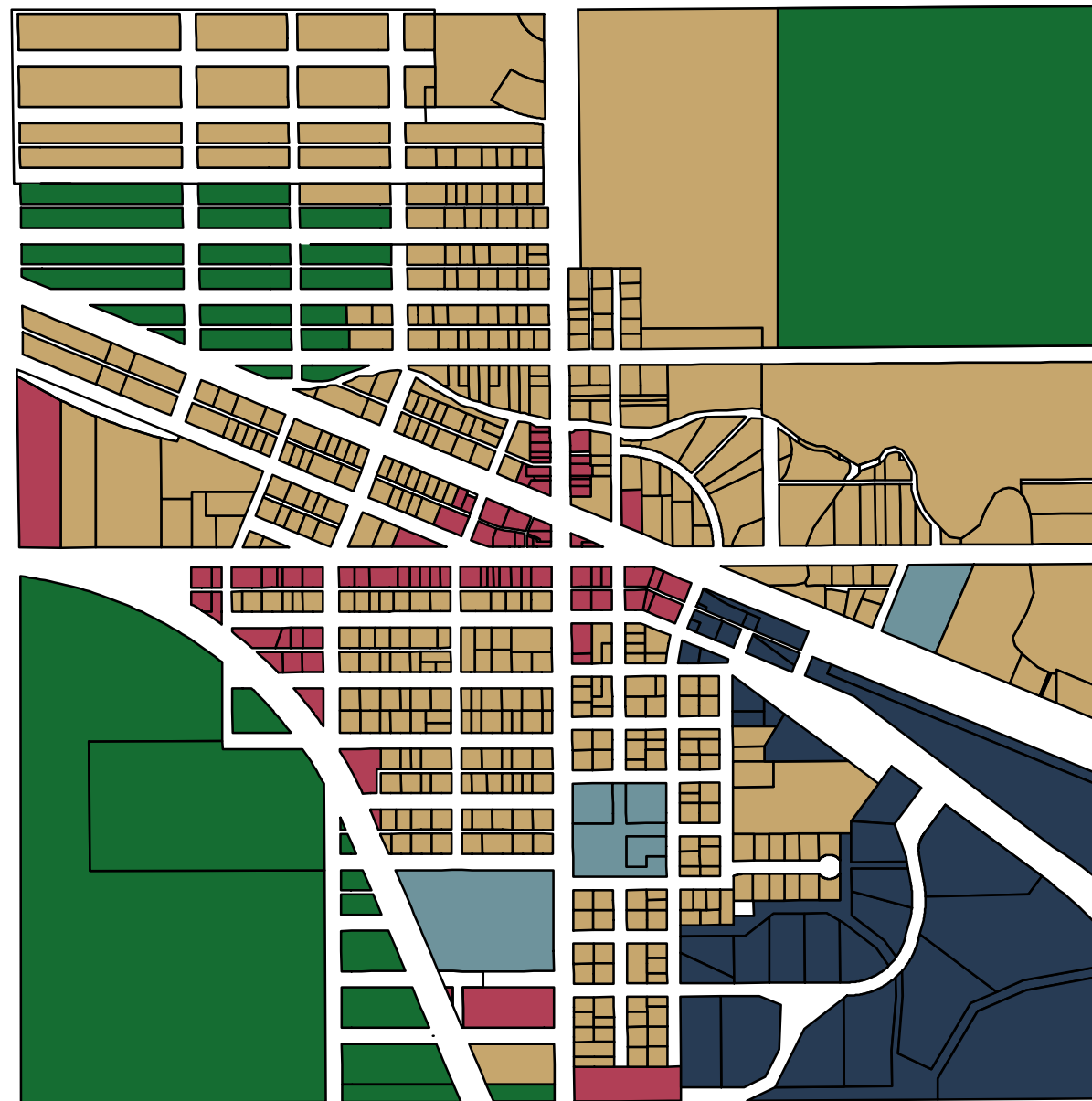
Gladstone's Population Change 1996-2011

Immigration to Gladstone 2001-2006

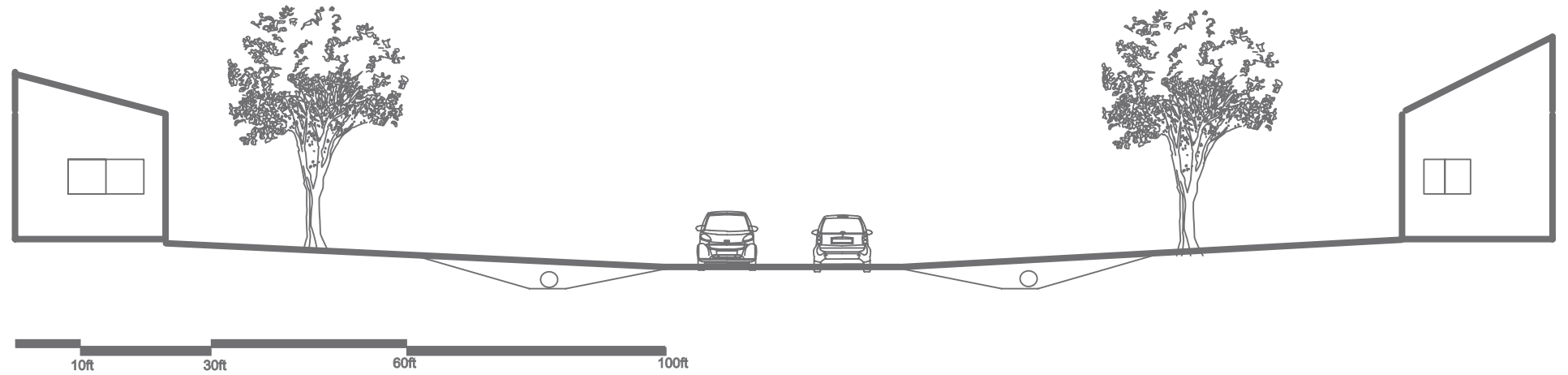




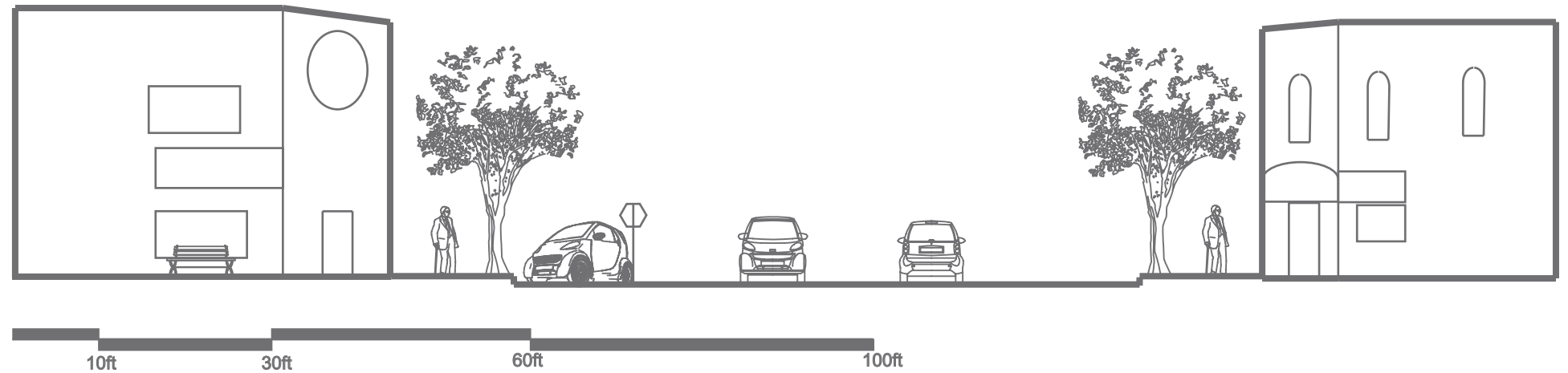
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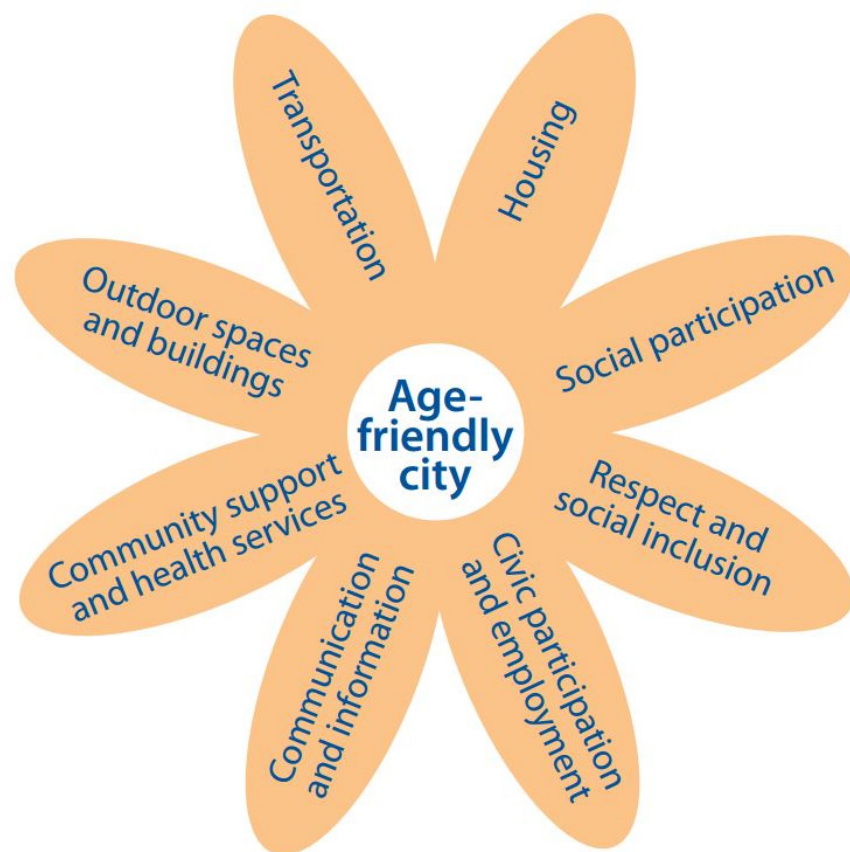

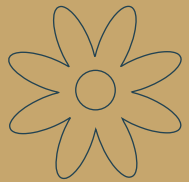
Observations
