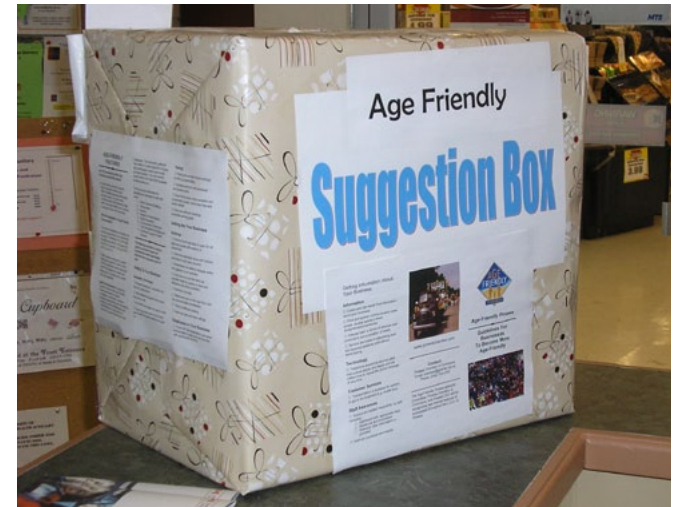
Population change from 1996-2006

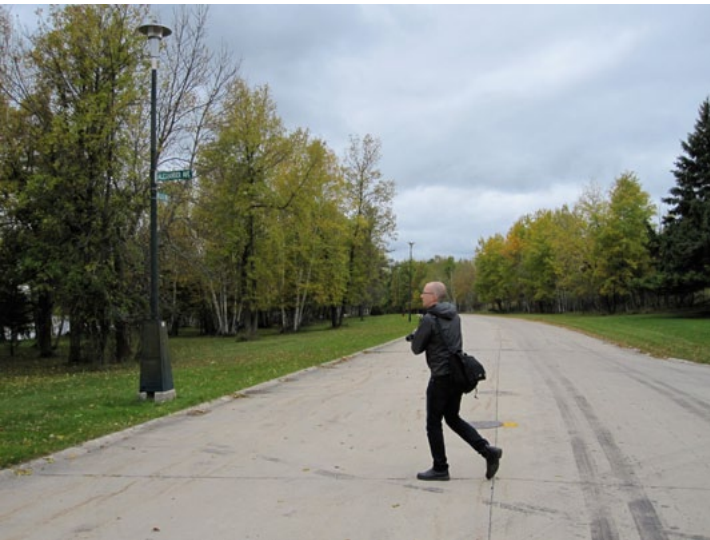
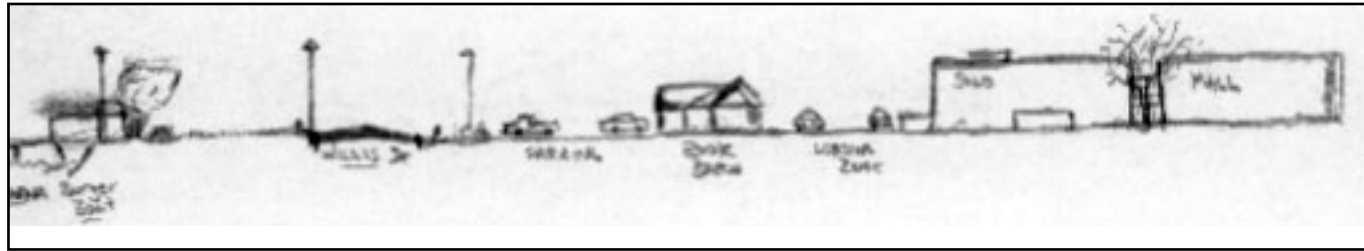


Age Friendly Pinawa Priorities:
